The National Centers for Environmental Prediction (NCEP) Climate Prediction Center (CPC) is accepting comments on terminating Redbook graphic images as part of the Days 3-14 U.S. Hazards Outlook operational production until November 4, 2018. Pending feedback, these graphics will be discontinued on November 6, 2018.

CPC currently releases the Days 3-7 and Days 8-14 U.S. Hazard Outlook graphic maps in several forms:

- Static portable network graphic (PNG) images on the web
- Redbook Graphic format via the Advanced Weather Interactive Processing System (AWIPS)
- Shapefile format also available via the web.
