Subject: Transition Long Range River Flood Risk Outlook (LRO) to  
Operational Status: Effective December 10, 2018

Effective Monday, December 10, 2018, the NWS experimental Long-Range  
River Flood Risk Outlook (LRO) will transition to operational status.

The NWS is now providing a nationally consistent, long-range river flood  
risk outlook displaying water predictions and probabilistic river  
forecasts on a national map. Stakeholders can access a single,  
nationally consistent map depicting the 3-month risk of minor, moderate  
and major, river flooding with access to more detailed probabilistic  
river forecast information.
