TEXT PRODUCTS ISSUED BY U.S. METEOROLOGICAL WATCH OFFICES AND VOLCANIC ASH
ADVISORY CENTERS...EFFECTIVE JANUARY 3 2000 AT 0000 UTC

THERE IS CURRENTLY NO STANDARD FOR INDICATING LATITUDE AND LONGITUDE
POINTS IN AVIATION PRODUCTS WHEN RESOLUTION FINER THAN A WHOLE DEGREE IS
REFERENCED. THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL AVIATION ORGANIZATION /ICAO/ AND THE
WORLD METEOROLOGICAL ORGANIZATION /WMO/ GIVE EXAMPLES WHICH ARE IN EITHER
DEGREES AND MINUTES OF A DEGREE OR IN DEGREES AND DECIMALS OF A DEGREE.
TO BE CONSISTENT WITH FLIGHT PLANNING AND MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS...CUSTOMERS
HAVE REQUESTED THAT REFERENCES BE TO DEGREES AND MINUTES OF A DEGREE.

BEGINNING MONDAY...JANUARY 3 2000 AT 0000 COORDINATED UNIVERSAL TIME
/UTC/...ALL REFERENCES TO LATITUDE AND LONGITUDE IN SIGNIFICANT
METEOROLOGICAL INFORMATION /SIGMETS/...AREA FORECASTS AND VOLCANIC ASH
ADVISORY STATEMENTS SHALL BE EITHER IN WHOLE DEGREES...OR IF FINER
RESOLUTION IS REQUIRED...IN DEGREES AND MINUTES OF A DEGREE.

EXAMPLES:

RESOLUTION OF A WHOLE DEGREE:

A REFERENCE TO 20 DEGREES NORTH LATITUDE AND 74 DEGREES WEST LONGITUDE
SHALL BE CODED AS...20N74W.

RESOLUTION FINER THAN A WHOLE DEGREE:

A REFERENCE TO 20 DEGREES 6 MINUTES NORTH LATITUDE AND 74 DEGREES 30
MINUTES WEST LONGITUDE SHALL BE CODED AS...2006N7430W.
