EFFECTIVE WEDNESDAY...JUNE 12 2002 AT 0000 COORDINATED UNIVERSAL TIME
/UTC/...THE NWS OFFICE IN PORTLAND OREGON WILL REVERSE THE DIRECTION OF
TWEB ROUTE 367 FROM KPDT-KDLS-KPDX TO KPDX-KDLS-KPDT. WEATHER CONDITIONS
EXPRESSED IN THIS PRODUCT WILL NOW BE PRESENTED FROM WEST-TO-
EAST...ALLOWING PILOT WEATHER BRIEFERS TO MORE ACCURATELY RELAY THE
INFORMATION TO PILOTS.

THIS CHANGE WILL NOT REQUIRE ANY ACTION FROM NWS PERSONNEL...FEDERAL
AVIATION ADMINISTRATION /FAA/ PERSONNEL OR EXTERNAL CUSTOMERS. THERE WILL
BE NO CHANGE IN THE COMMUNICATION PROTOCOL...INCLUDING WORLD
