/UTC/...THE NWS AVIATION WEATHER CENTER /AWC/ BEGAN MEDIUM LEVEL
SIGNIFICANT WEATHER FORECAST SERVICE FOR THE NORTH ATLANTIC OCEAN. AS A
PRODUCT OF THE WORLD AREA FORECAST SYSTEM...THE NORTH ATLANTIC MEDIUM
LEVEL SIGNIFICANT WEATHER CHART WILL INCLUDE FLIGHT LEVELS 100 TO 450 AND
COVER MOST OF THE NORTH ATLANTIC INCLUDING PORTIONS OF THE NORTHEAST
UNITED STATES...NORTHEAST CANADA...ICELAND...THE UNITED KINGDOM AND
