Subject: Implementation of Terminal Aerodrome Forecast (TAF) Service for:
PVW, Hale County Airport in Plainview, Texas: Effective November 25, 2014

Note: The following changes have no impact on NOAA Weather Wire Service subscribers.

Effective Tuesday, November 25, 2014, at 1200 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC), the NWS Office in Lubbock, TX, will begin TAF service for Hale County Airport in Plainview, Texas.

NWS personnel/offices will need to add the following identifier to their communications systems to receive the new TAF:
