WEATHER SAFETY NOAA WEATHER RADIO

It could save your life!

NOAA Weather Radio (NWR) provides continuous broadcasts directly from your local National Weather Service office. Weather information is broadcast in 3 to 5 minute cycles that includes forecasts, warnings, current conditions, and climate data. During hazardous weather, a special tone automatically triggers your weather radio to alert you of a dangerous weather situation.

Benefits of having a NWR



It's loud so it'll wake you up if you're sleeping when a life-saving alert is issued



It has a battery backup so it will still work if you lose power



It's easily programmable so you can customize what alerts you receive and which counties you are alerted for!



Adaptors such as strobe lights and bed shakers can be attached so that the radio is useable for those who are deaf or hard of hearing
