
Locally Heavy Rainfall and Flash Flood Threat Sunday PM

Key Messages

- Locally heavy rainfall Sunday afternoon into Sunday night may lead to isolated to scattered instances of flash flooding. Additional heavy rainfall is possible Monday afternoon and evening.
- Dangerous rip currents are likely through early next week.



Flash Flooding Threat:

- Rainfall Rates: 1 to 2"/hr.
- Flash Flood Impacts: Scattered instances of flash flooding of urban and poor drainage areas, as well as along quick responding rivers and streams are possible across NE NJ and Lower Hudson Valley. Isolated instances of flash flooding possible across NYC metro, western Long Island and southwest Connecticut.
- Timing: Sunday afternoon into Sunday night.
- Monday Outlook: Locally heavy rainfall is possible which may lead to an additional flash flooding risk.

Severe Thunderstorm Threat:

 An isolated severe thunderstorm cannot be ruled out Sunday afternoon and evening, mainly in NE NJ.

Beach Impacts:

- Dangerous rip currents at ocean beaches through early next week.
- High surf and beach erosion possible Sunday into Monday.
