



Key Messages

- Widespread minor to locally moderate coastal flooding expected through Friday night.
- Coastal Flood Watches are now in effect for Friday for S. Fairfield, Queens, the Bronx, S. Westchester and Nassau.
- Dangerous rip currents continue through the weekend.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- **Coastal Flooding** – Widespread minor to localized moderate coastal flooding with 1 to possibly 2 ft. of inundation for vulnerable coastal locales along the south shore bays of Nassau and Queens, Lower NY/NJ Harbor, and locations adjacent to western LI Sound.
- **Oceanfront** – A building easterly swell through this weekend will produce surf up to 6 ft. This will result in dangerous rip currents and minor beach erosion.

Timing and Location:

- Widespread minor coastal flood impacts expected today. Widespread minor to locally moderate coastal flooding expected on Friday.

- **Coastal Flood Statements** remain in effect today for eastern LI and coastal New Haven county CT.
