Key Messages

- Widespread minor to moderate coastal flooding expected through at least Saturday.
- Coastal Flood Warning has been issued for locations adjacent to Western LI Sound and the South Shore Back Bays of Western LI.
- Coastal Flood Watch has been issued for Saturday for S. Queens,
 S. Nassau, SW Suffolk
- Dangerous rip currents continue through the weekend.



Coastal Flooding

- Advisory Areas: ½ to 1 ft of inundation this evening, then 1 to locally 2 ft of inundation on Friday
- Warning Areas: Up to 2 ft of inundation

Oceanfront

A building easterly swell through this weekend will produce surf up to 6 ft. This will result in dangerous rip currents and minor beach erosion.

Timing and Location

- Areas of minor coastal flooding expected this evening.
- Widespread minor to moderate coastal flooding expected on Friday.
- Additional moderate coastal flooding possible on Saturday.

Coastal Flood Advisory in effect this evening for locations adjacent to Western LI Sound, Lower NY/NJ Harbor, and South Shore Bays of Western LI

- Coastal Flood Warning for Friday for S. Queens, the Bronx, S. Fairfield, S. Westchester, and Nassau Co.
- Coastal Flood Advisory for Friday for all other coastal locales outside of the warning area
- Coastal Flood Watch now in effect for Saturday for S. Queens, S. Nassau, SW Suffolk

• Minor to localized moderate coastal flood impacts remain possible through early next week, especially across LI's South Shore Back Bays.

By 6pm Friday unless there are significant changes.
