

Strong Winds and Light Interior Snowfall

Overview

- Strong winds develop late tonight, with gusts up to 50 mph expected through Thursday evening.
- Snow develops across the interior late this evening, with up to an inch or two possible in the higher elevations by Thursday morning.

HAZARDS

Strong Winds

- Peak Winds: Gusts up to 50 mph
- Location/Timing: Entire local Tri-State on Thursday
- Impacts: Strong winds will blow down limbs and blow around unsecured objects, including holiday decorations. A few trees and power lines could be downed and power outages are possible.

Light Interior Snowfall

- Snowfall: Up to 2 inches.
- Location/Timing: Portions of the Lower Hudson Valley and interior SE CT late this
 evening through Thursday morning.
- Impacts: Snow / snow showers may reduce visibility and create hazardous driving conditions, including during Thursday's morning commute.

NWS ALERTS

- Wind Advisory: Entire local Tri-State from 6 am to 10 pm Thursday.
- Gale Warning: All coastal waters from 6 pm this evening through Thursday night.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

 Localized gusts as high as 55 mph possible across far eastern Long Island and southeastern Connecticut on Thursday.


