



# Light Icing Friday Morning

January 30, 2025

## Key Messages

- A glaze of ice is expected Friday morning across portions of the interior.
- Any freezing rain changes to rain before noon.
- Any residual moisture on the ground is likely to refreeze towards dawn Saturday morning.

**WHAT'S CHANGED :** *Western Passaic in NJ has been added to the Winter Weather Advisory*

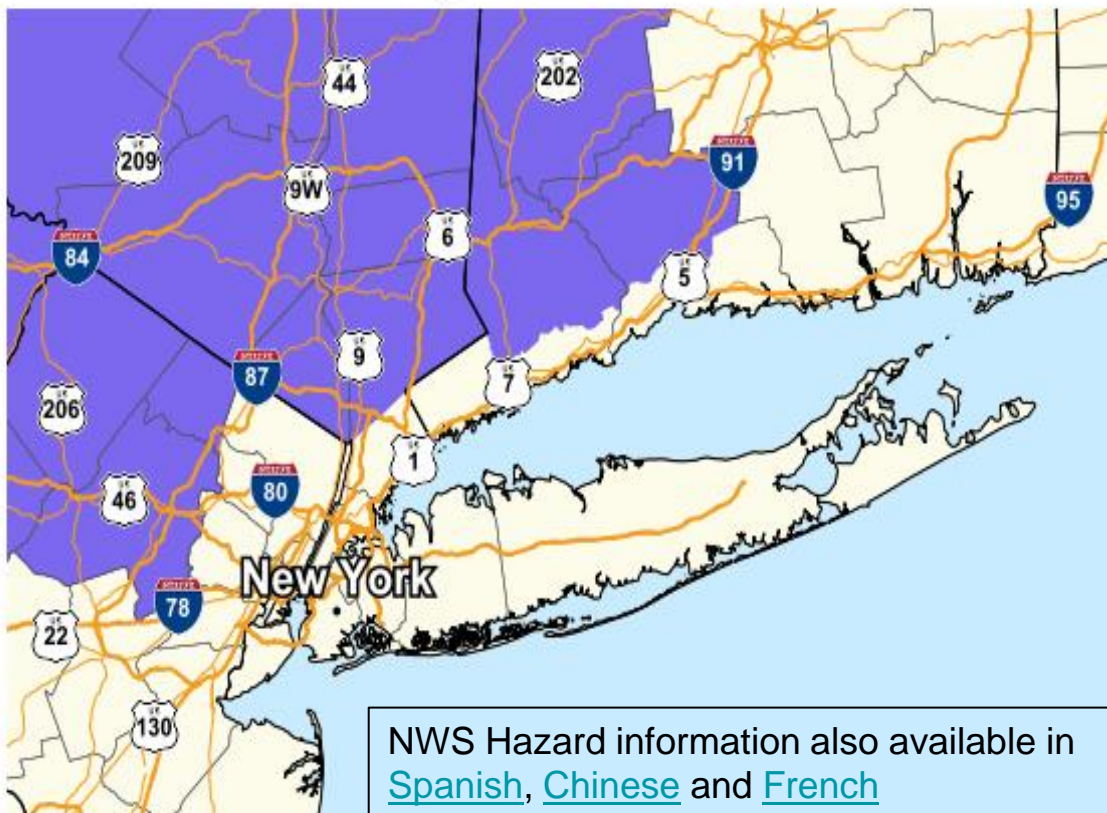
### HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- **Ice Accumulation:** Less than a tenth of an inch.
- **Refreezing:** There remains the chance of residual moisture freezing early Saturday morning, possibly ending as light snow across the far NW interior.
- **Impacts:** Pockets of hazardous travel can be expected Friday morning, with the potential for refreezing and potential black ice early Saturday morning.

### NWS ALERTS

- **Winter Weather Advisory:** Western portions of interior southern Connecticut, the Lower Hudson Valley, and Western Passaic in interior Northeast New Jersey.

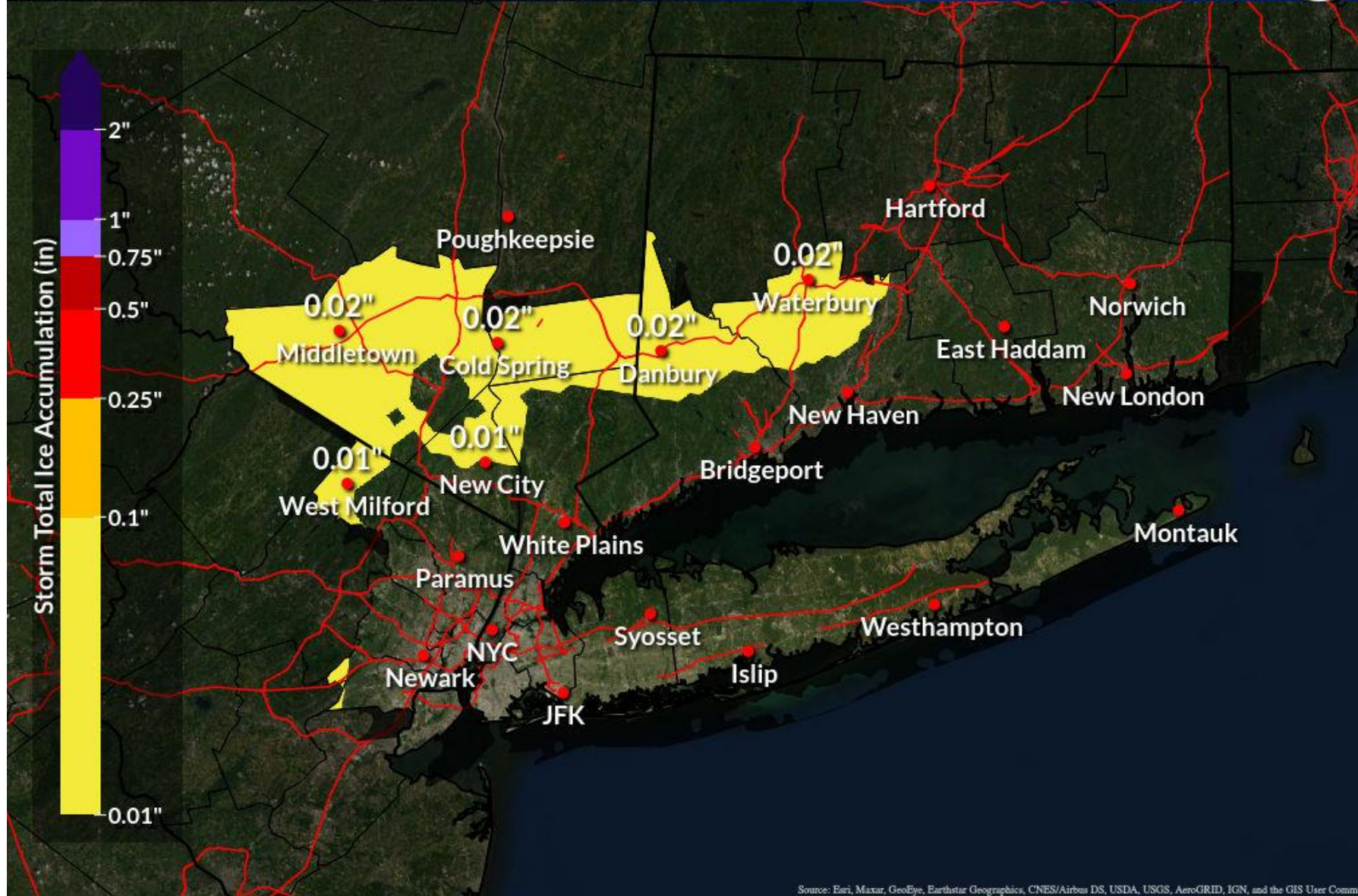
## Expected Ice Accumulation - Official NWS Forecast
