

Snow and Ice Expected Thursday

Winter Weather Advisory in Effect Thursday for the Interior

Key Messages

- Snow develops early Thursday, mixing with sleet and freezing rain into late morning, before changing to plain rain by Thursday afternoon.
- Travel impacts are expected for Thursday morning's commute.

Lower Hudson Valley, Interior NE NJ, and Interior Southern CT

- Total Snowfall: 1 to 2 inches.
- Ice Accretion: Glaze to a tenth on an inch.
- Timing: Snow develops from southwest to northeast after midnight, mixing with sleet and freezing rain late morning, before possibly tapering as plain rain early afternoon.
- Impacts: This could result in dangerous travel, with snow covered roads and icing on untreated and elevated surfaces. Expect hazardous travel during the morning commute.

NYC Metro, Long Island, Southern Westchester, and Coastal CT

- Total Snowfall: Up to 2 inches.
- Timing: Snow develops from southwest to northeast after midnight Thursday, briefly mixing with sleet mid morning, before changing to plain rain as temperatures rise above freezing into late morning.
- Impacts: This could result in snow covered roads and hazardous travel during the morning commute, particularly on untreated surfaces.


