## **Key Messages**

- An accumulating snowfall is likely Saturday evening into Sunday morning.
- The snow may transition to a wintry mix for NYC, northeastern New Jersey, and Long Island late Saturday night and early Sunday morning.

Winter Watches Warnings and Advisories

Lower Hudson Valley, Interior NE NJ, and Southern CT

- Snow Accumulation: 5 to 7 inches.
  - Snowfall Rates: 1"+/hr possible.
  - Impacts: Snow covered roads and difficult travel.

#### NYC, northeastern New Jersey, and Long Island

Snow/Wintry Mix: Accumulating snow of 3 to 5 inches possible Saturday night into early Sunday morning. The snow may mix with sleet around midnight into early Sunday morning. There is also a chance for freezing rain early Sunday morning. Plain rain may mix in where temperatures briefly rise above freezing.

- Snowfall Rates: Up to 1"/hr possible
- Impacts: Snow, sleet, and slush covered roads and hazardous travel.


**Extended Outlook:** There is potential (30-50%) for another accumulating snow/wintry







## **Most Likely Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast**










# **Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast**



Local snow amounts could be close to these where heavy snow banding persists. Local 6" amounts possible down to the coast if wintry mix is limited.






mix pushes further inland.
