**WINTER STORM WARNINGS AND WINTER WEATHER ADVISORIES ARE IN EFFECT**

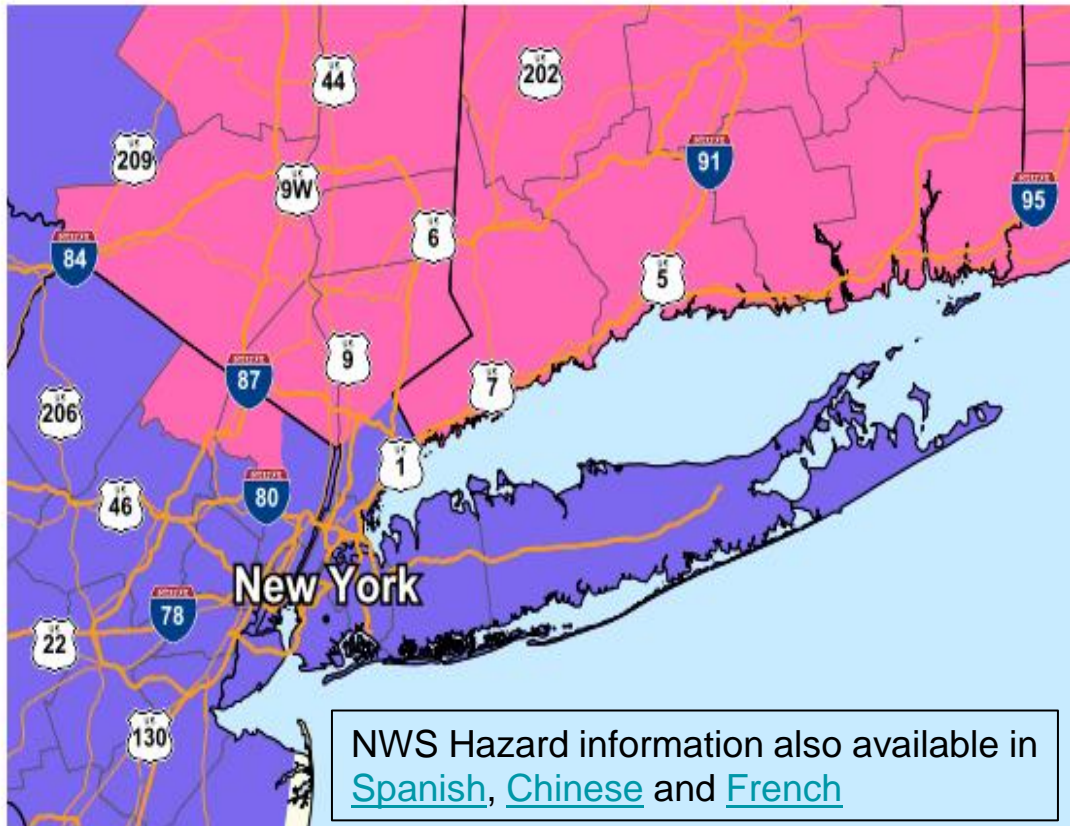
## Key Messages

- Snow starts late this afternoon and intensifies this evening. Snow accumulation is expected this evening into early Sunday morning.
- The snow will transition to a wintry mix for much of the area late tonight into early Sunday morning.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

### Lower Hudson Valley, Interior NE NJ, and Southern CT

- **Snow Accumulation:** 5 to 7 inches
- **Ice Accumulation:** Under a tenth of an inch, light glaze

### NYC, Northeastern New Jersey, and Long Island

- **Snow Accumulation:** 3 to 5 inches, locally up to 6 inches possible, especially NE Suffolk
- **Ice Accumulation:** Under a tenth of an inch, light glaze

**Snowfall Rates:** Up to 1-2" per hour from around 7PM today until 1AM Sun

**Impacts:** Snow, sleet, and slush covered roads resulting in hazardous travel

**Wintry Mix Overnight into Sunday Morning:** The snow will mix with or change to sleet and freezing rain. Plain rain may mix in where temperatures briefly rise above freezing, more likely along the coast as precipitation intensity lessens.

**Extended Outlook:** There is potential (30-50%) for another accumulating snow/wintry mix event Tuesday into Wednesday.

NWS ALERTS

**Winter Storm Warning 5PM Sat to 11AM Sun: Western Passaic NJ, Western Bergen NJ, much of the Lower Hudson Valley, and Southern CT**

**Winter Weather Advisory 5PM Sat to 11AM Sun: Rest of Northeast NJ, Southern Westchester NY, NYC, and Long Island**

FORECAST CHALLENGE

- Location and duration of any heavy snow banding.
- Duration of freezing rain and whether or not surface temperatures rise above freezing across portions of the NYC metro and Long Island late tonight into early Sunday morning.

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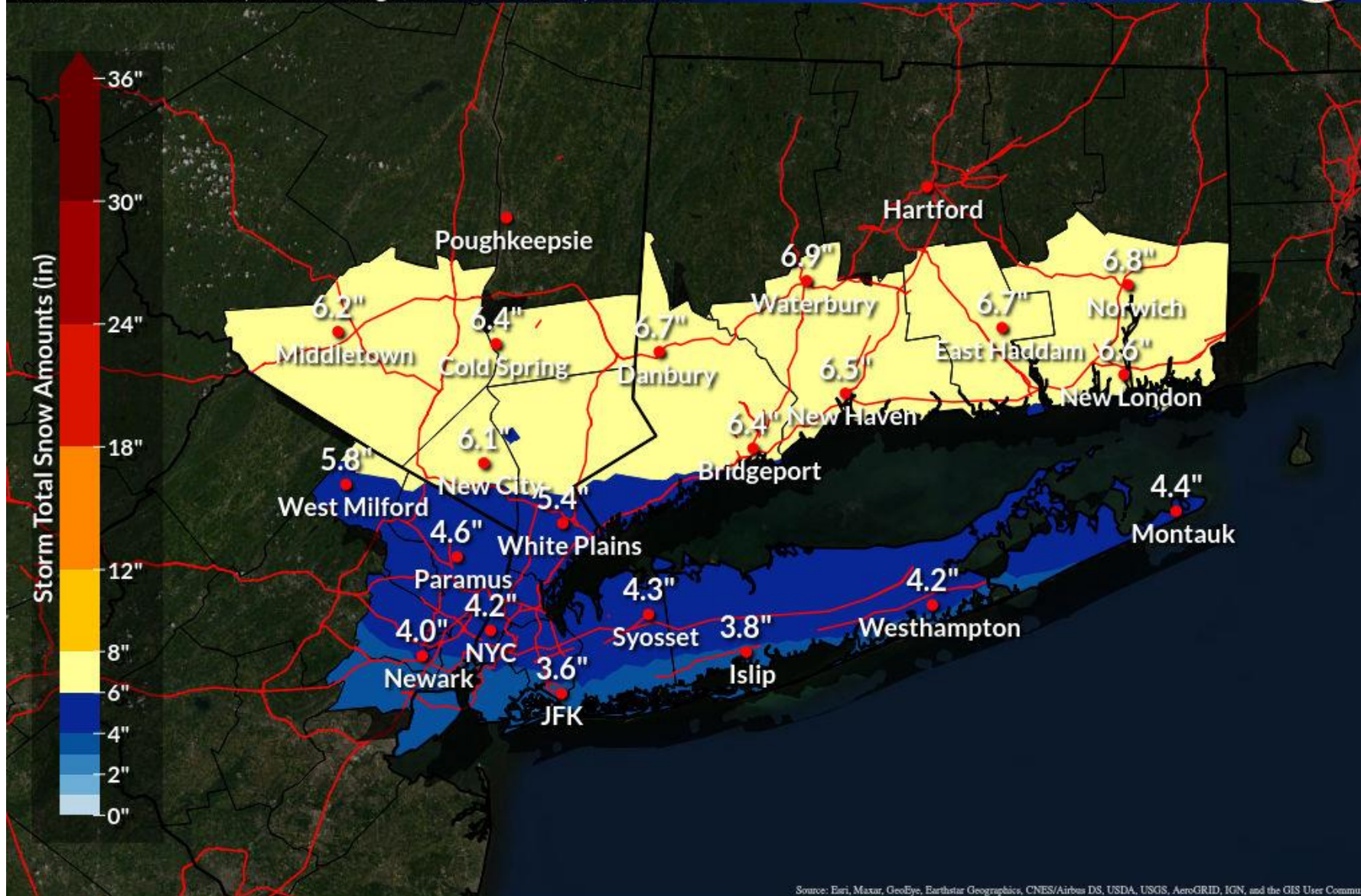

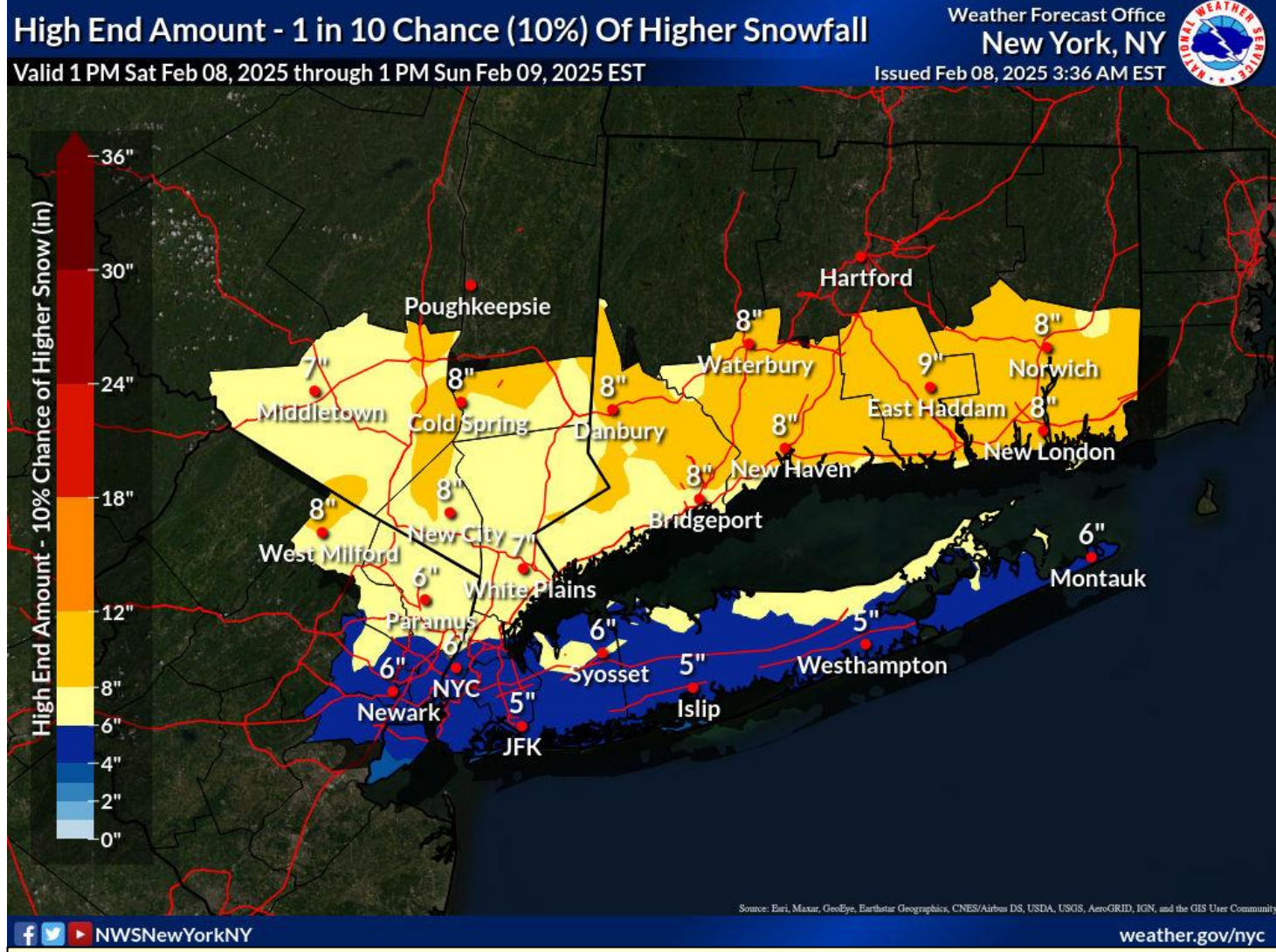

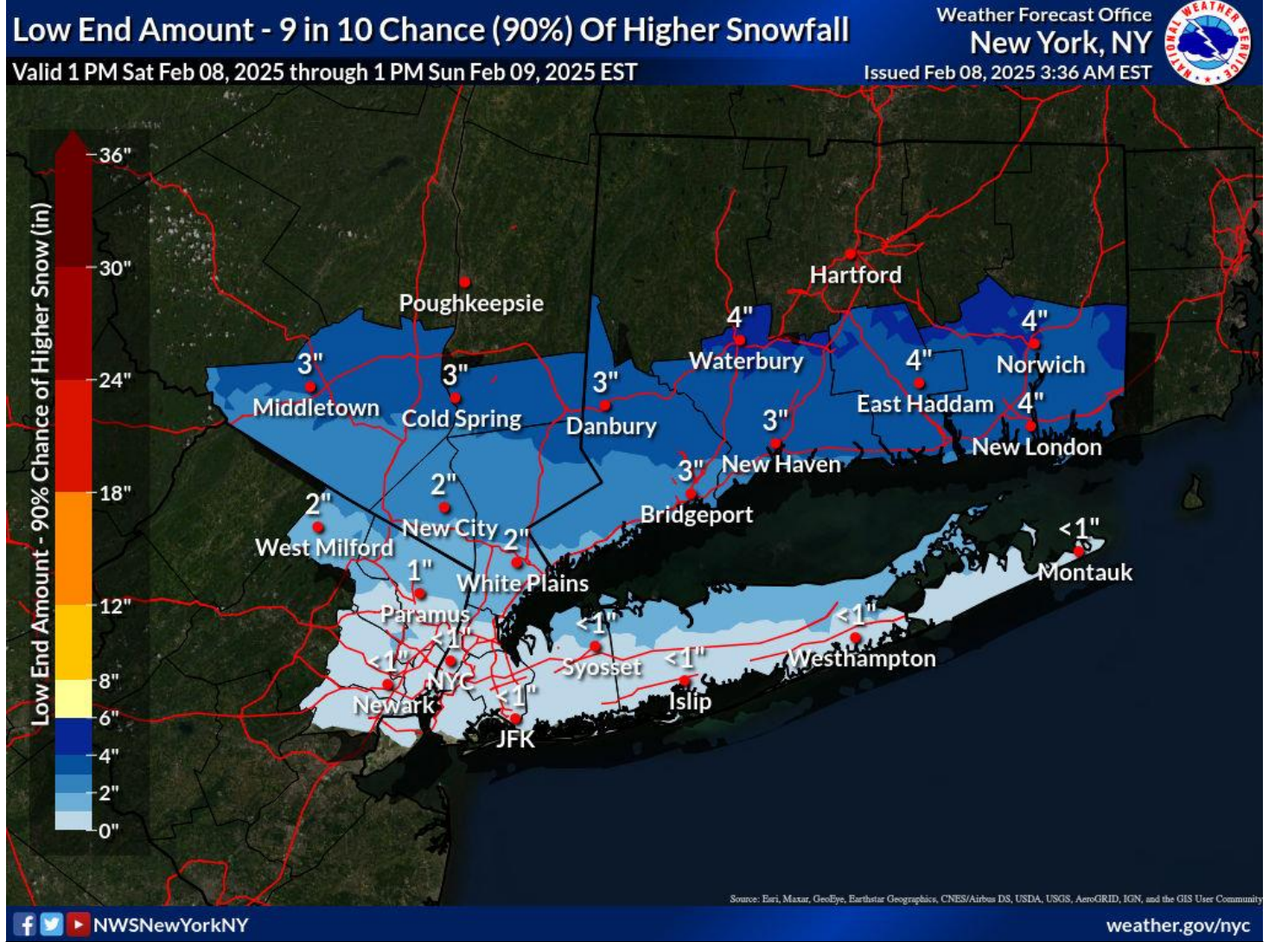


# Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast

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Local snow amounts could be close to these where heavy snow banding persists. Local 6" amounts possible down to the coast if wintry mix is limited.



Expect at least this much snow. Local snow amounts could be closer to these levels if the storm trends north or wintry mix pushes further inland quicker.



# Most Likely Ice Accretion - Official Forecast

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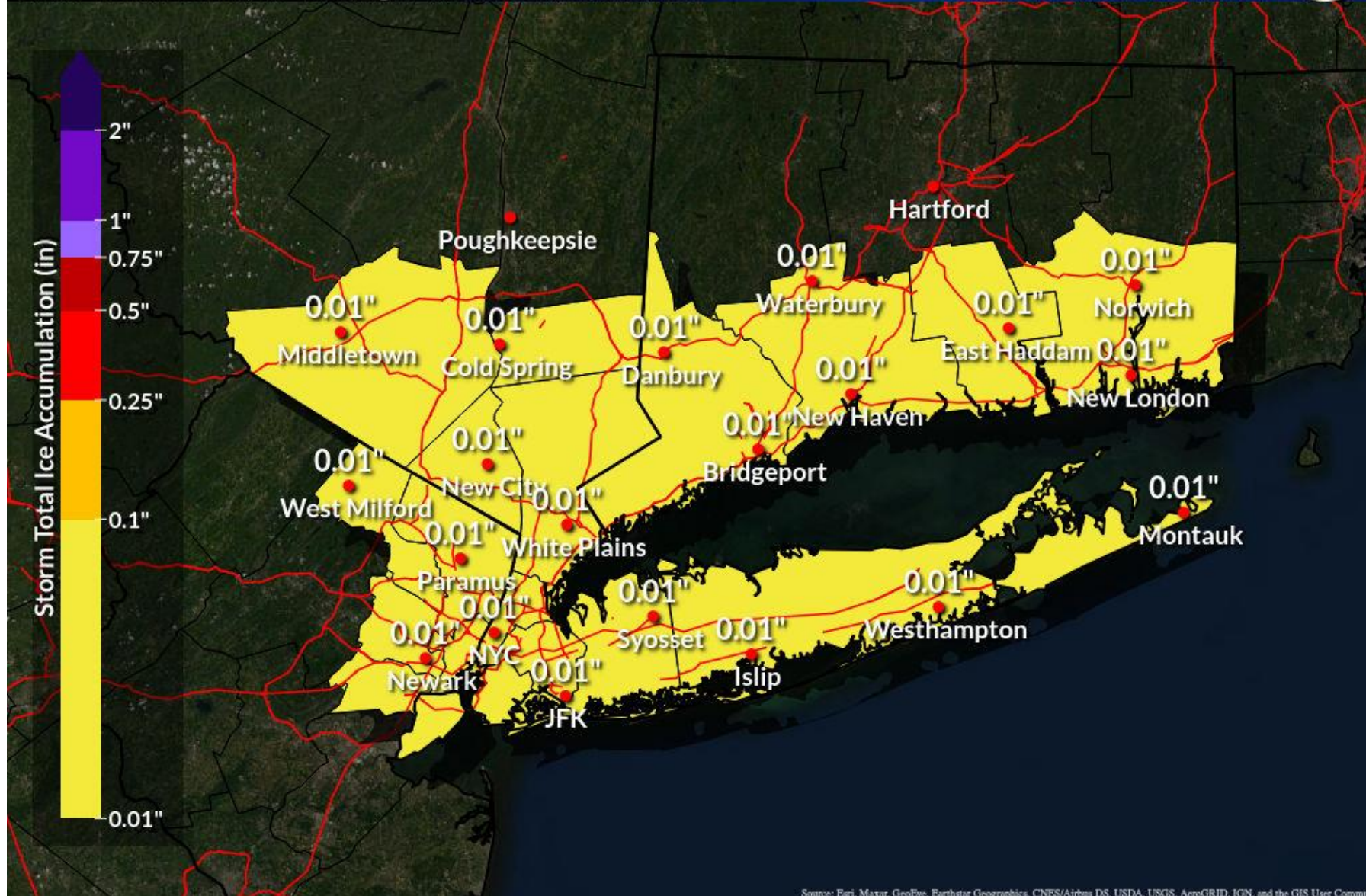
