

NWS New York, NY Seeks Summer 2025 Student Volunteers!

Description - The National Weather Service in Upton, NY (OKX) seeks <u>motivated students</u> that desire to learn more about the operations in a local weather service office. Students will learn many aspects of the day-to-day operations of the office, including warning operations and forecast creation as well as observation and product quality control. In addition, students will have the opportunity to participate in office research and outreach. This will give students the opportunity to determine whether a career with the National Weather Service may be right for them.

Length of Volunteership - Averages one to three days per week (~10-20 hours) starting in May 2025. <u>This is an unpaid, in-person experience.</u>

Eligibility - At least a half-time student pursuing an undergraduate (or graduate) degree in meteorology or atmospheric science that has completed their sophomore year.

What We Need From You - A cover letter stating your interest in the volunteership and why we should select you. In addition, please send your resume that includes the coursework you have completed and any related experience, transcripts, and at least two references.

Deadline - **Friday, Feb. 28th, 2025**. Applicants will be selected based on a combination of coursework, references, resume, cover letter, and a potential interview.
