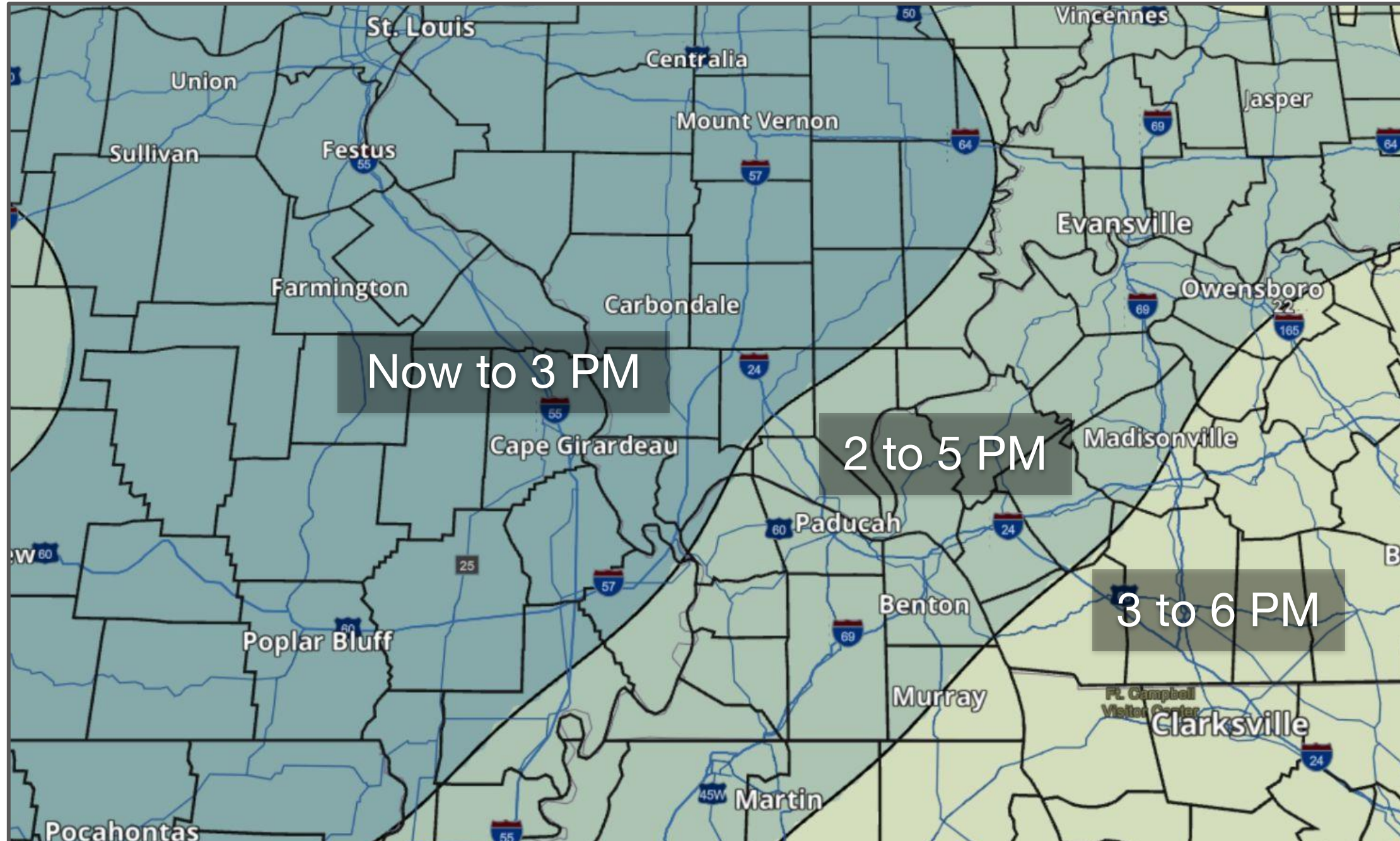


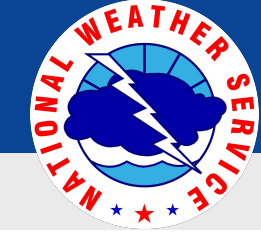


# Thunderstorm Arrival Timing

A couple rounds of thunderstorms are possible this afternoon and early tonight.



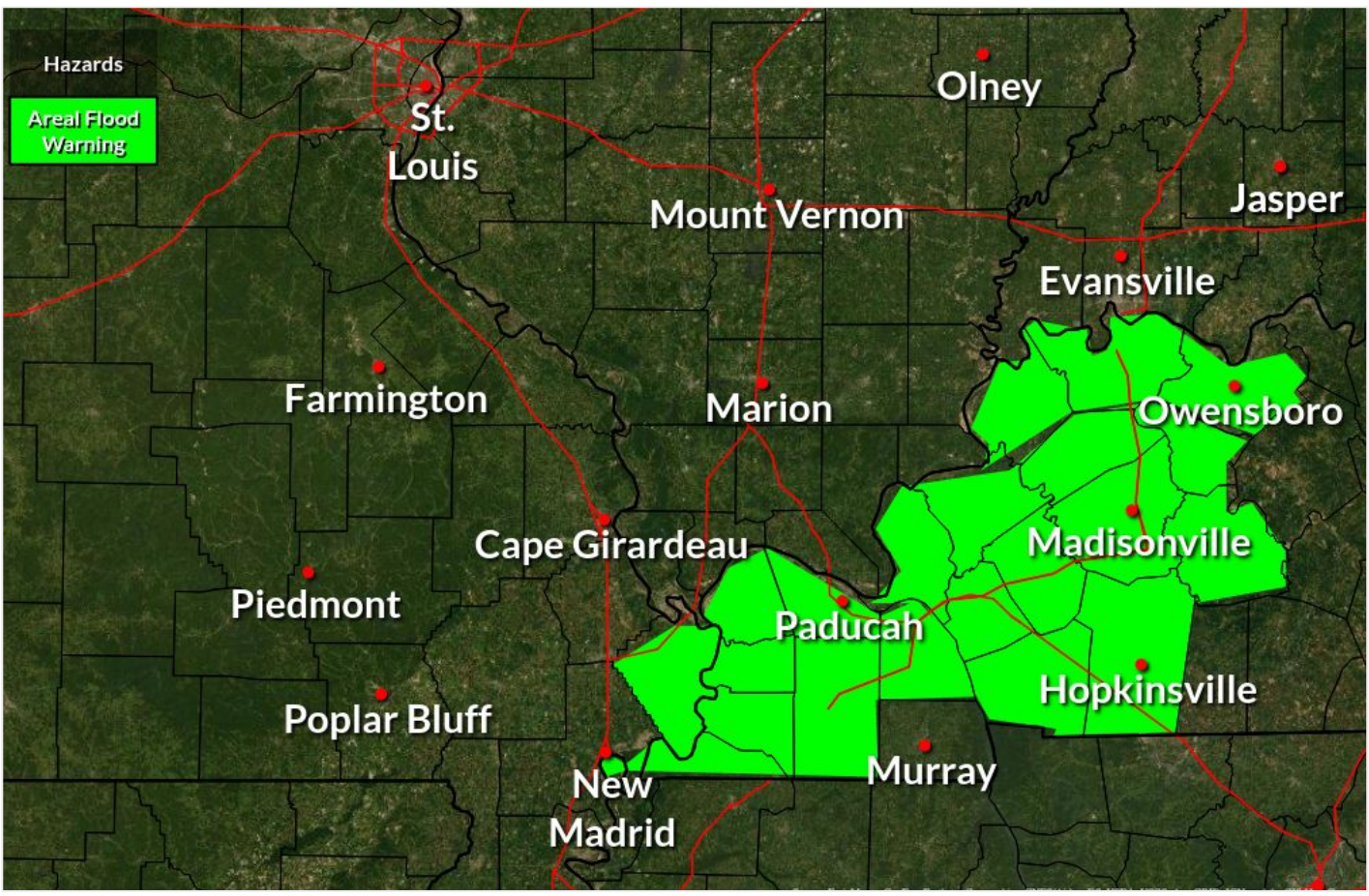


# Overland Flooding Continues This Week

## Current Areal Flood Warnings



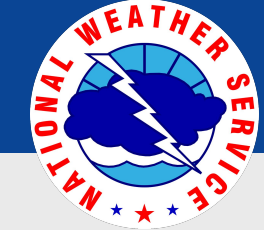
## Never Drive Around Barricades

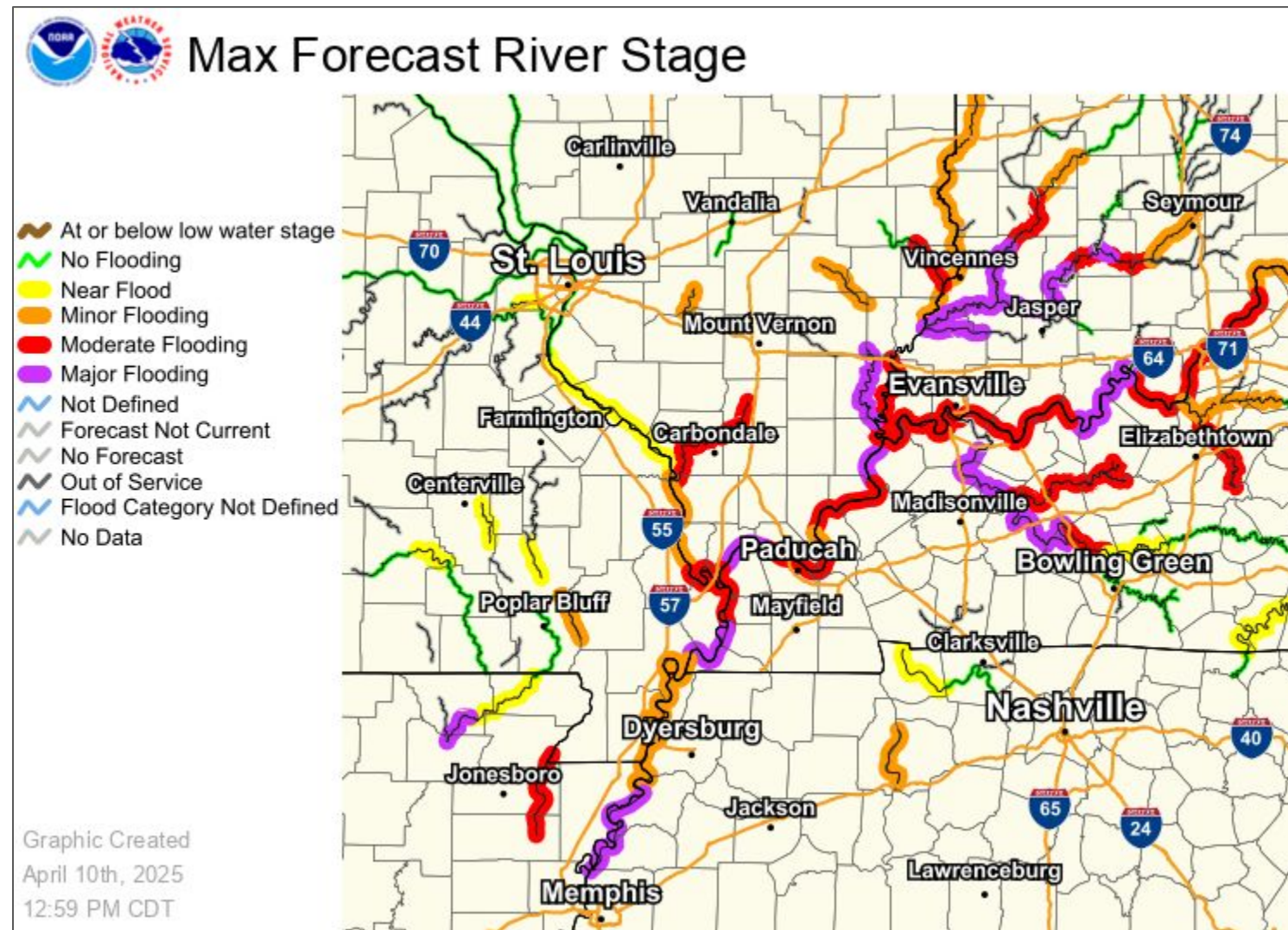


# Significant River Flooding Continues

# Stay clear of flooded roads:

Most flood deaths occur to people while driving.

- Don't drive around barricades.
- Do not attempt to judge water depth and drive through.
- Even if water appears calm, stronger current can be hidden further down in deeper waters.
- Debris in the water can be deadly.
- 12"-24" of moving water can sweep your car off the road.
