An isolated severe thunderstorm developed in southern Craig County of northeast Oklahoma during the late afternoon of December 9th and moved east into northern Delaware County. Thunderstorm winds gusted to 60 miles an hour in Bernice, and dime size hail also fell at Bernice. Nickel size hail covered the ground at the Grove Airport, and dime to nickel size hail nearly covered the ground at White Oak.
