

## 2024 Arizona Monsoon Outlook | Jun 15-Sep 30

**Precipitation (Jul-Sep)** 



4 in 10 Chance Drier Than Normal **Temperatures (Jul-Sep)** 



6 in 10 Chance Hotter Than Normal <u>Average Monsoon Rainfall</u> (1991-2020)

• Flagstaff: 7.63"

Tucson: 5.69"

• Kingman: 2.69"

Phoenix: 2.43"

• Yuma: 0.97"

Note: Monsoonal rainfall varies greatly across Arizona from as low as 1" in the deserts to over 10" in the mountains

## Reasons for a potential hotter & drier monsoon forecast

- Climate change (hotter and drier summers becoming more frequent across the Desert Southwest)
- Onset of high pressure may be delayed due to above normal soil moisture across AZ
- La Niña predicted this summer (70% chance) which could mean less Pacific Tropical Cyclone activity due to increasing wind shear
