Sergio (2018)

Dates: 29 September - 12 October 2018

Peak Intensity: Cat 4 Hurricane

A low pressure system moving in from the southern California coast tapped into subtropical moisture associated from decaying Tropical Storm Sergio, fueling thunderstorms over the Mojave Desert. A few storms produced flash flooding. Similarly, many flash flood events took place across the entire greater Phoenix metropolitan area but some events took place as far south as Casa Grande and as far southwest as Gila Bend.
